Hey there, paw-some savers! Collecting change is a fun and smart way to save money. If you've been adding change to your FAT CAT coin collector or a coin jar, check to see if it is about full. If so, now may be the purr-fect time to turn your coins into a savings deposit the **easy** and **fun** way with our Coinstar® kiosks¹, a free service for members. The machines are available at most SECU branches².



Here's how it works: Gather up all your coins—pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters, and half dollars. Bring them to a local SECU branch that has a Coinstar kiosk. With the help of a branch employee or an adult family member, pour the change into the machine. Don't worry, the coins won't just disappear, they'll be counted! Then, you can use the receipt to deposit the money into your FAT CAT Share Account. Watch your money increase with each deposit!
